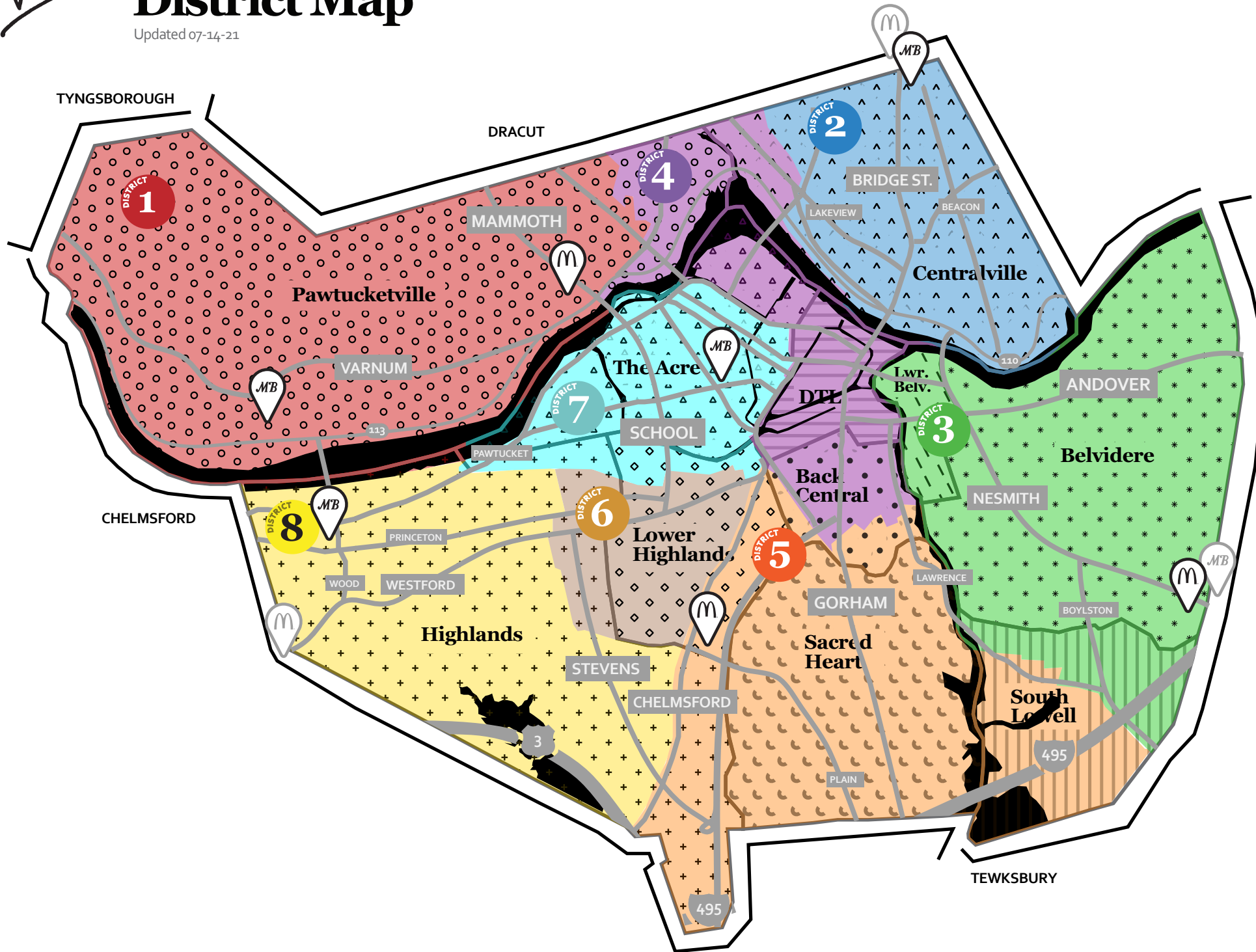


City Council District Map

What's in a District?

The new district map establishes eight, approximately equal districts, two of which are "majority minority," where Asian-American residents and Hispanic/Latino residents together comprise a majority of the citizen voting age population.

While they hew closely to neighborhood lines, some districts span neighborhoods or split off small portions in order to ensure equal representation based in census data.



Where did these borders come from?
