



What's in a District?

The new district map establishes four, approximately equal School Committee districts. One of these is "majority minority," where Asian-American residents and Hispanic/Latino residents together comprise a majority of the citizen voting age population.

While they hew closely to neighborhood lines, some districts span neighborhoods or split off small portions in order to ensure equal representation based in census data.



Where did these borders come from?
