

Seeking: Voter Outreach Field Team Members

Position Hours and Timeline: July-November 2021. 4-8 hours a week September-November.

Hours are flexible but availability in the late afternoon-early evening and up to two weekend days per month is required.

Compensation: \$15/hr

Summary: Lowell Votes' Field Team will work to: 1. Inform the community of the new voting districts and system, and 2. Register new voters and provide information on candidates and their stand on issues important to the community, and mobilize voters to participate in elections.

Lowell Votes is a community-based, non-partisan, grass-roots initiative to increase voter participation in Lowell, Massachusetts. We aim to increase voter access particularly for minority and under-engaged voters and advocate for local government transparency and accountability. This year is an especially important year for Lowell Votes due to the city's transition to a new election system and new voting districts.

Specific duties and task

- Attend trainings on best practices for engaging the public, explaining Lowell's new voting system and districts, and mobilizing voters.
- Distribute educational materials and engage Lowell residents in conversations on voting and the new election system including flyering in businesses, door knocking and phone-banking.
- Register new voters through tabling in public spaces.

Qualifications:

- Fluency in English (Additional languages preferred: Spanish, Portuguese, Khmer)
- Strong verbal communication skills
- High comfort level going door-to-door and speaking with people over the phone about voting-related issues
- Interest in and some knowledge of civic engagement, voter education, voter mobilization
- Familiarity with Lowell and connections to the community are strongly preferred
